"In the midst of the great outdoors, the spirit will find peace all by itself," says Brigitte von Boch. The farming tradition of the 330 hectare estate was combined with its use as a hotel. Linslerhof is home to 45 horses, and spacious stalls are available for guest horses. A hunting school and falconry enrich the multifaceted range of activities.

In addition to Linslerhof, the Romantik Hotel Kieler Kaufmann in Kiel, the Romantik Seehotel Eichenhain in Neustadt-Pelzerhaken, the Romantik Hotel Reichshof in Norden, the Romantik Hotel & Restaurant Hirsch in Sonnenbühl-Erpfingen and the Romantik Hotel zur Oberen Linde in Oberkirch are joining the Romantik Hotels brand.
